Sub:-WCD & SCW Department – Sexual harassment of women at workplace Act 2013(Prevention and Redressal) – Constitution of Local Complaints Committee – Orders – Issued.

Government of India have made act named by Sexual harassment of women at workplace Act 2013(Prevention and Redressal) to prevent and redress of harassment on women at workplace.

Under section 5 of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal), Act 2013, the Government of Telangana notified the District Collector of every district as District Officer under the Act vide reference 2nd cited.

Sub section (1) of the section 6 stipulates that every district Officer shall constitute in the district concerned, a committee to be known as the Local Complaints Committee to receive complaints of sexual harassment from establishments where the internal Complaints Committee has not been constituted due to having less than ten workers or if the complaint is against the employer himself. The Local Complaints Committee shall consist of the following members to be nominated by the District Officer (District Collector).

1. A Chairperson to be nominated from amongst the eminent women in the field of social work and committed to the cause of women.
2. One Member to be nominated from amongst the women working in block taluka or tehsil or ward or municipality in the district.
3. Two members of whom at least one shall be women to be nominated from amongst such non-governmental organisations or associations committed to the cause of women or a person familiar with the issues relating to sexual harassment which may be prescribed. Provided that at least one of the nominees should preferably have a background in law or legal knowledge.

Provided further that at least one of the nominees shall be a woman belonging to the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes or the other Backward Classes or minority community notified by the Central Government, from time to time.

4. The concerned officer dealing with the social welfare or women and Child development in the district shall be a member ex officio.
5. The District Officer shall designate one nodal officer in every block, taluka and tehsil in rural or tribal area and ward or municipality in the urban area, to receive complaints and forward the same to the concerned Local Complaints Committee within a period of seven days.

In this regard, Local Complaints Committee, Wanaparthy district is here by constituted with the following members.

The Chairperson and every member of the Local Complaints Committee shall hold office for such period not exceeding three years from the date of their appointment as may be specified by the District Officer.
