






SUPERVISED SUPPLEMENTARY FEEDING PROGRAMME (SSFP)



HANDWASH & HYGIENE

To protect children from diseases, always wash hands with water and soap.

WHAT TO REMEMBER





If you don't wash hand with soap & water. the germs will go from your hands to the food.



The germs will then move from the food to the child's stomach.



And as a result, the child will fall sick.



WHAT TO DO AND WHAT NOT TO DO





Keep water and soap close to the child's feeding place



Wash hands with soap before feeding the child



Use ladle to draw water



Don't dip your hands in water for washing



Don't wipe your hands with your saree



Do not keep drinking water uncovered
